Student Council Minutes

November 7, 1949

The meeting was called to order at 5:02 P.M. by President Joe Loughlin. Roll call was taken. The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

George Emminger submitted the three estimates received thus far for the Student Directory.

Steve Andras thanked Council for support in the previous election of Vice-President.

Al Cronig reviewed the suggestions for a new Coca Cola machine. Al Hasenauer made a motion that the Student Lounge Committee be allowed to purchase this machine on the payment from profit basis. Seconded and carried.

N.S.A. Gene Penler requested speaking privileges in Council concerning the Jefferson Military College that refused a fifty million dollar grant for refusing to advocate teaching of Christian white supremacy. Mr. Penler reported that a congratulatory telegram had been sent to Jefferson College by the N.S.A. Committee of the Rochester Institute of Technology. Mr. Penler suggested that we send this college a token sum in appreciation of their action and requested that a motion be made. Discussion followed. Al Cronig made a motion that Student Council donate \$25.00 to the Jefferson Military College to use as they see fit. Seconded. Motion was defeated.

John Carney made a motion that we allow N.S.A. to use Student Association's name to a monetary contribution collected by the N.S.A. Committee. Motion was seconded and defeated.

Dora Schaefer made a motion that the meeting be adjourned. Seconded. Meeting was adjourned at 5:37 P.M.
