

ROCHESTER INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY

Student Council Minutes
November 28, 1949

The meeting was called to order at 5:03 P.M. by President Joe Loughlin. Roll call was taken. The minutes of the previous meeting were read and corrected.

The chairman summarized the organizational meeting held on Tuesday, November 22. Two main topics discussed were: (1) the organization and activities do not submit enough news to Sprit, (2) the content of Sprit was questioned. A board was formed to survey the needs of the student body pertaining to Sprit. The board is to consist of the Executive Committee of Council, Sprit editors and four other students. Roger Stabley made a motion that the executive committee be granted permission to join in the survey. A meeting of this board will be held on Thursday, December 1, at 4:30 P.M., room 120 of the Eastman Building.

Because of congested travel conditions expected on Christmas it was agreed by the Administration Policy Committee that classes close on Thursday evening, December 22, to allow students time to reach their homes. The administration notified Student Council of this action, which was taken as a result of recommendations received from the council a short time ago. The administration also asked for cooperation of council in stressing with the students the fact that they are expected, in view of the above action, to attend classes as scheduled through Thursday without additional time off.

The Master Mixer sponsored by the Alumni Association, will be held on Saturday, December 3, at 8:00 P.M. in the Eastman Lounge. Steve Andras asked for more volunteers to help work on the committee. A meeting of the mixer committee will be held on Tuesday, November 29, at 12:30 P.M. in the Student Council office.

Claudia Symonds announced that R.I.T. is to receive the N.S.A. National Art Exhibit on December 8, for six days. Plans are under way for display in the Bevier Building and for inter-collegiate and city publicity. R.I.T. is one of thirty five schools to receive the exhibit this year.

Miss Symonds asked permission of Council to send Gene Penler to Syracuse Saturday, December 3, for a regional executive N.S.A. meeting. Steve Andras made a motion that permission be granted to Gene Penler to attend this meeting, so he can stress the case of having the next N.S.A. regional meeting at R.I.T. in the spring. The motion was seconded and carried.

R.I.T. will play host at the next Geneva District N.S.A. meeting on December 12, in the cafeteria.

President Loughlin announced that no more parking stickers will be available because of lack of space. Discussion followed and suggestions

were made for marking parking spaces and the possibility of hiring a parking attendant.

Tom Burke has been appointed chairman of the Awards Committee.

Steve Andras made a motion that the meeting be adjourned. seconded and carried. The meeting was adjourned at 6:38 P.M.
