Student Council Minutes
January 30, 1950

The meeting was called to order at 5:03 P.M. by president Joe Loughlin. Roll call was taken. The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Mr. Pease was introduced to Council and recommended that students might be interested in a lecture offered by Miss Anderson concerning hygiene. Miss Anderson will be in Rochester, March 5 through the 14. Separate lectures would be given to male and female student audiences. Al Cronig made a motion that we form a committee to investigate the possibility of having Miss Anderson as guest speaker at R.I.T. Seconded and carried. Those volunteering for the committee were:

Mr. Killip of Bastian Brothers Co. said that students whose orders were accepted for rings on November 30, and who have not received their rings as yet, may call for them at Bastian Brothers Company, 1600 Clinton Avenue.

The chairman announced that committee reports will be due at the next Council meeting, February 6.

The secretary read a letter from the librarian, Mrs. Steinmann, concerning the distribution and placement of electrical literature in the library. Mrs. Steinmann explained where the magazines are routed, and in the future more will be available for students.

Steve Andras regreted to inform Student Council of the death of Joseph Cheresnowsky, Publishing and Printing freshman. The Executive Committee sent flowers in behalf of the student body.

Steve Andras made a motion that in the event of the death of any faculty member or member of the student body, Student Council shall make it a standing obligation to acknowledge same by appropriate action. Motion seconded. Carried.

Since Al Hasenauer has been unable to continue as a member of Student Council, Mike Zakour has been appointed to take his place.

Steve Andras read an invitation from Geneseo State Teachers' College to R.I.T. male students to be their guests at a school dance scheduled for February 11. Further information will be obtained.

It was advised that the present temporary Constitution be adopted permanently until the revised Constitution is ratified. Same was placed the form of a motion by Dora Schaefer. Seconded and carried. Thus voiding a technicality in the ratification of the new Constitution. It was also suggested by the president that all Student Council members

acquaint themselves thoroughly with the Constitution now up for ratification. Any proposed amendments shall be submitted in written form. The suggested procedure will be to read and discuss each article individually.

Al Cronig announced that Dick Santucci, Photo Tech. has volunteered to serve on the Student Lounge Committee.

Steve Andras made a motion that the meeting be adjourned. Seconded and carried. The meeting was adjourned at 5:45 P.M.
