Student Council Minutes
February 20, 1950

The meeting was called to order at 5:04 P.M. by President Joseph Loughlin. Roll call was taken. The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

President Loughlin read a letter from Mr. Warren Davis concerning hanging drapes or installing venetian blinds in the Techmila office. He also read one from Mr. William Torporcer concerning students parking their cars on Institute property. Students have been parking in the faculty parking lot on South Washington Street next to the Christian Science Church. Again Student Council is asking the students not to park in the faculty parking lots.

President Loughlin announced that there will be a meeting of the Publications Committee Tuesday, at 12:30 to decide on the Editors of Spirit, Techmila and the Student Handbook for 1950-51.

The next issue of Spirit will carry a special notice on N.S.A. Federal Scholarships. All students are asked to pay particular attention to this article as it may come up for discussion here at R.I.T.

Morris Miller, Student Representative to the Alumni Association, reported to council that the Alumni Association is looking into the possibilities of air-conditioning the Eastman lounge. Mr. Miller asked council for suggestions in ways to improve the Clark Building lounge. Collier's and Time magazines in Clark Union are gifts of the Alumni Association. The Alumni Association is prepared to help us decorate the Clark building lounge. Mr. Miller, representing the Student Lounge Committee, submitted estimates of \$260.00 for 6 - 4 florescent tubes for lighting in Clark Union. Larry Weinberger made a motion that we approve the Lounge Committee's request for \$260.00 to install six lights in Clark Union. Motion seconded and carried.

The chairman then turned the meeting over to Larry Weinberger, chairman of the constitution committee. Mr. Weinberger began with Article 5 of the By-Laws - Section I - in section 6 the following words were added "except as prescribed in the by-laws".

The election procedure mentioned in Article 5, section 7 was discussed. Motion was made and was seconded that a maximum of five minutes be given to campaign speeches. Motion defeated. Eugene Penler asked that the election procedure be conspicuously posted in the Student Council office. Motion was made to adjust the section as it stands. Seconded and carried. Mr. Penler withdrew his request so there was no need for a vote.

It was moved that in Section 4, of Article 6, we add "nominations from the floor shall be in order at all times by both the old and new council members". Motion not seconded - denied.

Dolores Santy made the motion that we carry on next Monday with Article 8. Seconded by Roger Stably - carried.

Joe Loughlin made the motion that the meeting be adjourned. Seconded
Steve Andras. The meeting was adjourned at 6:10 P.M.
