Student Council Minutes
February 27, 1950

The meeting was called to order at 5:05 P.M. by President Joseph Loughlin. Roll call was taken. The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Mr. Killip of Bastian Brothers Company will be in Student Council office on Thursday, March 2, at 4:00 P.M. and again at 7:00 P.M. to take orders for school rings.

The Spring Carnival has asked permission to use the Eastman Lounge and the Clark Union Lounge for record sessions as publicity of the Carnival. Dora Schaefer made a motion that the Spring Carnival Committee be granted permission to use the lounges in connection with the publicity of the Spring Carnival.

Clarence Matthews asked for Council members to help solicit for blood donors for the Red Cross. Those volunteering from each department were:

These people are to meet in the Student Council office Tuesday, February 28, at 12:30 P.M. to collect literature for the publicity of the Blood Donor Campaign.

Gene Penler, N.S.A. Committee was granted permission of speaking privileges in Council. Mr. Penler read the endorsement of the Federal Scholarship Aid to Education by the N.S.A. Committee of Rochester Institute of Technology. A similar bill will be brought up in Congress in the very near future, therefore Mr. Penler asked for immediate endorsement of this plan. Discussion followed. It was suggested by Larry Weinberger that we table this discussion until Council members can better acquaint themselves with the information concerning the Federal Aid to Education.

The chair was then given to Larry Weinberger to continue the discussion of the Constitution. Mr. Weinberger began with Article 8 of the By-Laws.

Laura Goldman made a motion that we delete, Chairman, of the Program Committee from Article 8 since the Vice-president is automatically Program Chairman. Motion seconded and carried.

Article VIII, Section 11. Alma Lee Loy made a motion that we add as Section 7, "this committee shall cooperate with the representatives of the faculty and administration on the information - planning of the social program. Seconded and carried.

John Waite made a motion that we strike out the word, "will", and submit, "y", after the Rochester Institute of Technology in the second paragraph of the Civics Committee. Discussion followed. Motion seconded. Carried.

Leon Stashak made a motion that we add a section 21 to Article VIII of the By-Laws stating that every committee should have a written statement of purpose and functions. Seconded and carried.

Clifford Pratt made a motion that the meeting be adjourned and that we continue with the discussion of the Constitution, Article IX of the By-Laws at the next meeting. Meeting was adjourned at 6:08 P.M.
