Student Council Minutes  
Monday, May 1, 1950

The meeting was called to order at 5:02 P.M. by President Joseph Loughlin. The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

The annual meeting of Student Council will be May 22, at which time officers of 1950-51 will be elected by vote of incoming council only.

Mr. Killip of Bastian Brothers will be here May 10 with the rings which were ordered in January and February. He will take additional orders for rings at this time.

A request from Techmila for a subsidy of \$30.00 for a banquet was made through President Loughlin. Motion was seconded and carried. Techmila is a service organization.
