Student Council Minutes  
October 18, 1950

5:15 P.M. The meeting was called to order by President Richard Santucci at Roll call was taken. The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Red Mueller, chairman of the Lounge Committee, requested Council's approval of the kleenex dispenser for the Eastman Lounge. The floor machine would be installed in the Eastman Lounge on a commission basis. Each five-cent package sold would give council a profit of 0.5¢. Discussion followed.
