Student Council Minutes
October 30, 1950

Dora Schaefer moved that Council present the prospect of selling fruit baskets to some of our needy organizations. Seconded and carried.

Council discussed the Fencing Club's request for \$315.00 from the Reserve fund. Norman Lampe moved to allot Fencing Club \$300.00 from the Reserve Fund. Seconded and carried.

Hope Wagner presented a recommendation that something should be done with the worn out ping-pong tables in the Clark Lounge. The problem was referred to the Lounge Committee.

Dora Schaefer moved that the meeting be adjourned. Seconded and carried. The meeting was adjourned at 5:54 P.M.
