Student Council Minutes
December 4, 1950

The meeting was called to order by Vice-President Tom Burke at 5:10 P.M. The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved. Roll call was taken.

Hope Wagner submitted the NSA report on the Regional Conference held jointly between the U. of R. and R.I.T. According to the evaluation reports, the conference was successful. The regional executive committee is considering having the next conference at Buffalo with the U. of B. and Buffalo State Teachers College acting as hosts.

The report of the Athletic Board of Control Committee was submitted by Ken Cox. It stated that copies of the handbook of the Athletic Board were distributed and the contents reviewed. The main purpose of the meetings was to review the budgets for varsity sports. The board recommended to Student Council that wrestling and basketball budgets be approved for amounts approved last spring. The board recommended to Student Council that fencing and tennis budgets be considered on the same basis as wrestling and basketball. The board agreed to recommend to council that it provide a coach for the fencing team. Application of baseball and fencing to be recognized as varsity sports was submitted and discussed. The board approved a suggestion that coaches and faculty advisors for these sports (when chosen) appear before the board to be briefed on the responsibilities and obligations to be observed by sports to continue on varsity basis.

Hope Wagner, chairman of the Commencement Announcement Committee, reported that announcements will cost from 12¢ to 13¢ each depending on the company we do business with.

Carol Babosuk announced that an informal Xmas party will be held for Council Wednesday, December 13, at 7:30 P.M. The place of the meeting will be announced.

Vice President Burke announced that Mike Zakour was appointed chairman of the "Spring Carnival Weekend".

Dora Schaefer brought up the questions that the money spent on intramural basketball be transferred to department organizations. Dick Santucci moved that the topic be referred to the Athletic Board of Control. The motion was defeated.

Quentin Decker inquired why the Clarissa Street entrance to the parking lot is closed. The matter was referred to the Parking Lot Committee.

Mrs. Robson informed Council of the Blood Donor Service Campaign that can be held at R.I.T. Either the Blood Mobile can be brought here, or students may be taken to the blood bank. Students under 21 years of age, must have their parent's consent. It was approved by Council to wait until after exams to hold the campaign. It was requested that racial discrimination be looked into in connection with the Blood Donor Service.

A Social Chairman Meeting is to be held Tuesday at 12:00 noon.

Dora Schaefer moved that the meeting be adjourned. Seconded and carried. The meeting was adjourned at 6:05 P.M.
