Student Council Minutes  
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The meeting was called to order in Room 100 in Clark Union, by President Richard Santuci at 5:08 P.M. The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved. Roll call was taken.

The general impression concerning the new meeting place for Student Council in Clark Union was favorable.

Bob Johnson reported on the Blood Donor Drive. Of the quotas set for each department, 127 pints have been pledged. All blanks are to be filled out and turned in by Feb. 15 at 4:00 P.M. Blanks can be obtained from a student Council representative, the department office, or Miss Behr.

Pres. Santuci reported that at the meeting of the Cultural Development group and the Alumni Committee, it was unanimously agreed to have more people use Clark Union. Volunteer aid from a women's Church group has been donated for weekends, and is considering donating a TV set unless funds are available at R. I. T. Other suggestions were to install a small soda fountain, a film forum in Clark Union, and more student assemblies.

Jack Stumpf requested information concerning the operation of the R. I. T. book store. Discussion followed. Tom Burke recommended that a more organized method for future years concerning student kits be installed.

Standing Committee reports are due Feb. 19th.

Mrs. Robson congratulated the Blood Donor Drive Comm. on the excellent work they have done.

Dora Shaefer moved that the meeting be adjourned. Seconded and carried. The meeting was adjourned at 5:45 P.M.
