Student Council Minutes larch 5, 1951

The meeting was called to order by President Richard Santuci at 5:09 P.F. The minutes of the previous meeting were read, corrected, and approved. Roll call was taken.

Tom Durke introduced Fr. Magberg, Chairman of the Athletic Board of Control, and Fr. Florescue, fencing coach. Fr. Burke explained to Council the problem concerning Fr. Florescues salary as coach of the fencing team. Student Council paid for the first 2 months of practice amounting to \$80. The problem is that the institute has contracted to pay the fencing coach for the entire year, and if Council should be reimbursed for the amount paid prior to the action taken by the Institute. Discussion followed and it was agreed on by Fr. Florescue and Er. Magberg that Council would be reimbursed. Tom Murke called a meeting of the Budget Conmittee for next Tuesday at 5:00 P.F. Mr. Magberg requested a budget allotment for the Grestling team over the previous appropriation. Action was tabled until further study of this year's budget by the rudget Committee.

Don Tarleton, of M.S.A., reported on the W.S.S.F. in relation to R.I.T. Council recommended that the chairman of W.S.S.F. have the power to continue research and decide which country R.I.T. can aid, with the consent of Council.

Stan Dudek reported on the progress made concerning the revision of the Book Exchange's policy and activity. Granville Fentley and Jerri wright, of the N.S.A., will assist by Dudek in setting up a policy to be used, the books to be used and to find out the opinions of supervisors, faculty, and students on the rew policy.

Cornell approved the appointment of Leonard Surzer and Roger Marmaart as alternate members of the Athletic Board of Control.

Jim Amos proposed that the parking restrictions on Spring and ashington Streets be removed. Discussion Followed. Dora Shaefer moved that students be urged to park in the Student Farking Lot. Seconded and corried.

James Mondorf recommended that Student Council finance a ping pong tournament at R.I.T. It was reforred to the Eudget Committee for further investigation. Red Mueller and Dick Santuci will investigate the possibilities of a tournament.

Standing Com ittee reports are due March 12.

Dora Shaefer moved that the meeting be adjourned. Seconded and carried. The meeting was adjourned at 3:12 P.M.
