Student Council Minutes
March 12, 1951

The meeting was called to order by President Richard Santuci at 5:10 P.M. The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved. Roll call was taken.

Pres. Santuci introduced Paul Eucci and Robert Spinney, P & P freshmen, and Bill Blake, Ret. freshman, as representatives to Council.

Pres. Santuci introduced Mr. S. W. Bell, who presented the suggestion for a student play production at R.I.T. Discussion followed. Council decided to wait until next year to take any action.

The meeting was turned over to Al Oliveri, chairman of the Constitutional Committee. Mr. Oliveri explained the proposed amendments to the Constitution. Dick Santuci moved that the amendment to Article IV Section 4 be bypassed. Seconded and carried. Council moved that By-Laws, Article III Section 7 be bypassed. Seconded and carried. Dora Shaefer moved that Article IV Section 6 be reworded to state that "the student Council shall hold regular office hours, Monday through Friday, from 12:00 to 1:00 P.M., to be publicized. Seconded and carried. It was moved that Article VIII Section 22 be bypassed. Seconded and carried.

Norman Lampe, chairman of Publications committee, reported that a further delay in the publication of the Student Handbook and Directory is laid to the illness of the Instructor in charge.

Ruth Clark of the Assembly Committee, explained that many of the assemblies had to be cancelled because of the inability to secure a main speaker. Aiding Miss Clark are Ruth Farley, Bob Spinney, and Paul Eucci.

Pres. Santuci introduced Editor-in-Chief of Spirit, Nelson Hodgkins. Mr. Hodgkins spoke concerning Student assemblies and Council activities. He expressed the desire to publicize events beforehand and not after they have taken place.

Norman Lampe reported on the ping pong paddles and balls. Mr. Lampe was requested to present his proposal to the Lounge Committee and the Budget Committee.
