Student Council Minutes
April 9, 1951

The meeting was called to order by President Richard Santuci at 5:08 P.M. The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved. Roll call was taken.

Hope Wagner of I.S.A., reported that April 5 & 7, R. I. T. and the U of R were hosts to 8 engineering students from Argentine. The group toured the city, visiting many industrial plants and both R. I. T. and the U of R campuses. Saturday R. I. T. entertained at a luncheon for the visitors.

The Lounge Committee reported that \$11.40 has been allotted to the ping pong tournament for paddles and balls.

Tom Burke, chairman of the Awards Committee, announced that there will be a meeting of the Committee Wednesday at 12:15 P.M. in the Student Council office.

Mike Zakour, chairman of Spring Weekend, spoke to Council concerning this weekend. He announced that Friday noon a pep rally has been planned. Spring St. will be blocked off - no cars being parked between 12:00 and 1:00 P.M. between Plymouth Ave. and Washington streets on Spring St. Free beer will be given to the students. Bill Torrow of the Parking Lot Committee reported that Chairman Jack Stumpf cleaned up glass from the lot, and put stickers notifying violators to buy stickers if they want to use the lot. Discussion followed concerning the use and operation of the parking lot.
