OLD BUSINESS-The Women's Dorm constitution was approved. The motion was defeated to change Article VII Section 4a of the By-Laws to read as follows: If in the case of a tie in the election of the President and/or Vice President, Council shall decide the election.

NEW BUSINESS-The Student Council crest was displayed. Further discussion will take place next week.
