Regarding Final Course Grade Dispute Policy, make appropriate changes to policies related to D17.0 to address issues with references to the Academic Appeals Sub-committee. Make necessary changes in order to revise inconsistencies in Policy D08.0 and D18.0

Recommendation:

The subcommittee recommends the following changes:

D08.0 STUDENT ACADEMIC INTEGRITY POLICY

Section VII. Academic Integrity Appeals states: "The instructor or the student may appeal the findings of the Academic Integrity Committee to the Academic Appeals Sub-Committee of the University Appeals Board (see Policy D18.0, section VI section IX, item G).

D17.0 FINAL COURSE GRADE DISPUTES

Part III, section B: "Final Course Grade Dispute Committee Membership: The Final Course Grade Dispute Committee shall consist of three instructors (senior or principal lecturer, tenured, or tenure-track) and may be part of the same pool of instructors who sit on the Academic Conduct Integrity Committee (See Policy D8.0-Academic Integrity Policy)."

D18.0 STUDENT CONDUCT PROCESS

Throughout the document, revise all timelines specified in days to read "business days". This addition is needed in the following sections:

Section IX. Appeal for the Student Code of Conduct

Cases originating from the Center for Residence Life. For cases heard by the Center for Residence Life, the follow is applicable:

<u>a.</u> Within_three (3) <u>business</u> days, the Student intending to appeal must submit the basis of the appeal in writing to the Student Conduct Appeals Coordinator.

G. Procedure for UAB Appeals

1. Within three (3) <u>business</u> days of receiving the determination of a conduct hearing, the Student must submit the basis for appeal in writing to the Student Conduct Appeals Coordinator.
