- Coming to you today to briefly outline work of committee thus far and to ask your help in solidifying agenda for this Summit
- Committee meeting weekly to discuss issues of governance on departmental,
 college and university levels
- Researched history of RIT faculty governance and reviewed current documentation of role of faculty in governance in reports such as Future Faculty, and COACHE as well as recommendations contained in the Middle States Report regarding governance
- We also held **3 focus groups** in which faculty discussed issues of governance
- Salient points taken from these groups include:
 - Participation: What are the definitions for roles in all governance positions? Who should participate and how should they be trained?
 - Communication: How do we insure that participants are prepared for discussions and how do we disseminate information to the campus before and after these interactions?
 - Consistency and Transparency: How do we reduce the redundancy of information between participants, committees and across colleges involving issues of governance?
- Because these were **small groups relative to the population of faculty** on our campus, our next step is to take these concerns to a larger audience.
- We will be sending out a survey relatively compact that touches on these concerns
- Purpose of survey will be to provide further focus on issues of governance across campus and thus help us to identify the agenda, speakers and time for this summit
