- 1 A minimum of 30 credit hours shall be successfully completed in residence at the university in the
- 2 college granting the degree (inclusive of service courses). If the student has successfully completed
- 3 30 credit hours in residence, a petition may be submitted to the dean to study 10 credit hours in
- 4 absentia in the final year of the degree; at a minimum, 20 of the final 30 credit hours are to be
- 5 completed in residence.

## Deletions

- 1 A minimum of 30 credit hours shall be successfully completed in residence at the university in the
- 2 college granting the degree (inclusive of service courses). If the student has successfully completed
- 3 30 credit hours in residence, a petition may be submitted to the dean to study 10 credit hours in
- 4 absentia in the final year of the degree; at a minimum, 20 of the final 30 credit hours are to be
- 5 completed in residence.

## New Text

- 1 A minimum of 25% of the total semester credit hours required for the degree shall consist of
- 2 successfully completed RIT courses. The degree-granting program shall decide which specific
- 3 courses and how many total semester credit hours shall count to satisfy this requirement.
