- ▶ Course release typical

# Vice Chair

- ▶ Attend Board of Trustees meetings
- ▶ Appeals Committee representation
- ▶ Communicate New policy to President/Provost
- ▶ May attend SG or SC

# Operations Officer

- ▶ May attend Board of Trustees sub-committee meetings
- ▶ Enable effective running of AS meetings (Robert's Rules of Order)
- ▶ May attend SG or SC

# Communications Officer

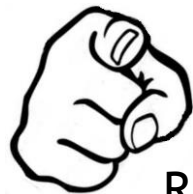
- ▶ May attend Board of Trustees sub-committee meetings
- ▶ Fully engaged in RIT Policy
- ▶ Takes minutes, listens to recordings, ensures accurate record keeping of AS meetings
- ▶ May attend SG or SC

# Treasurer

- ▶ May attend Board of Trustees sub-committee meetings
- ▶ As with *all* Ex.Comm. positions, is a member of the point-liason between faculty administrators, BOT, SG, SC.
