UNIVERSITY EXPLORATION

University Exploration (UE) is the university-wide undecided program for RIT. Students in the program have the opportunity to explore majors across the 9 colleges of RIT. Although students whose credits place them at 3rd-year standing** are not eligible to enter UE, the advising services of UE are available to all undergraduate RIT students.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Applicants to University Exploration (UE) are expected to follow these steps before being reviewed for admission to the program. Decisions for entry are made after grades are released at the end of the semester.

- Meet with one of the UE academic advisors to discuss your current standing and potential exploration interests. Schedule a meeting with this [online form](#).
- Work with your current academic advisor to complete a Change of Program form and send the form, along with your statement, to University Exploration (findyourdirection@rit.edu).
- In general, applicants should be in good academic standing (GPA of at least a 2.0).

The UNIVERSITY EXPLORATION PROCESS

- Enroll in our one-credit hour course, Career Exploration Seminar (ITDL 101)
- Take major-specific courses across multiple majors
- Work closely with your academic advisor to refine your interests and majors
