Children and their families in Henrietta can learn or practice sign — the expressive hand and body language of the deaf and hearing impaired — in classes starting Monday night in the Henrietta Public Library (registration requested at 334-3401). Lavina Hept, an instructor at NTID will teach the classes, running in groups of four for 6-10-year-olds (July 12, 13, 19 and 20) and for families (July 14, 15, 21 and 22). Both sets of classes will be repeated in August. "Kids here are very much into sign because of the large deaf population in Henrietta," said Nancy Maxwell, periodical librarian. "But we also welcome people who can't sign a word."
