Grant Cos, Assistant Professor, and Susan Barnes, Associate Professor, both in the Department of Communication, recently were awarded individual FEAD Grants. The grant to Dr. Cos supports his attendance at a three-week seminar on the history and philosophy of freedom of expression. The seminar will be offered in England from July 3-23 at the University of Cambridge and the University of Oxford. Attending the seminar will benefit Dr. Cos's undergraduate course, "The Rhetoric of Free Speech" and his graduate course, "Communication Law and Ethics."

Dr. Barnes will use her FEAD Grant (with colleague Dr. Deborah Blizzard) to develop instructional materials for a new course to be entitled "Reality TV and the Construction of Reality." The course will be available to DOC majors – PTC and APR – as a professional elective.
