Dr. Keith Jenkins, Assistant Professor in the Department of Communication, today is awarded the Isaac L. Jordan Pluralism Award at a noon-time ceremony in the SAU Fireside Lounge.

The Jordan Award, established in 2003, is given to an outstanding individual who has contributed in unique ways to diversity and pluralism. Dr. Jenkins teaches courses in Intercultural Communication and the Rhetoric of Race Relations, among others, for the Department. From July 1999 to June 2002 Dr. Jenkins was the Institute's first Assistant Provost for Diversity. His lengthy list of accomplishments and activities, each focusing on student success and meaningful community participation, have long been known across the Institute.
