

PTC Students Can Earn an MBA in One More Year

The Department of Communication and RIT's College of Business have forged a new agreement whereby PTC students can earn their MBA degree with one more year of classes.

Ordinarily, earning an RIT MBA requires two additional years of study beyond a student's B.S. degree. But, PTC students eligible to enter the 4-plus-1 program by following a specified curriculum, can complete their MBA 12 months after earning their PTC degree.
