A course entitled "Landscapes of Public Memory: Travel Study in Athens, Greece" is being offered by two well-known communication experts: Dr. Sonja K. Foss (University of Colorado at Denver; Sonja.Foss@cudenver.edu) and Dr. Bernard J. Armada (University of St. Thomas; bjarmada@stthomas.edu).

The course focuses on the communicative construction of public memory, a form of history that is established and maintained in the imagination of a culture through books, the media, rituals, and public memorials. The creation of public memory is a distinctly rhetorical process in that the symbolic resources of a community are used to fashion a shared sense of the past. Alive with sites of history, archaeology, and art and having just hosted the 2004 summer Olympics, Athens is an ideal location to study the construction of public memory.

Estimated Cost: \$2,400-2,800 (Includes tuition, lodging, breakfasts, excursions, and insurance. Roundtrip airfare to Athens is an additional \$600-800.)

Application Deadline is October 2, 2004 and students are encouraged to apply early, as course enrollment is limited to 15.
