A total of \$25,000 is available to support research in broadcasting, especially research on economics, business, social or policy issues of importance to the U.S. commercial broadcast industry. PTC and CMT students preparing for their thesis requirements may find the grants of particular interest.

The grants are available from the National Association of Broadcasters (NAB); last year six grants were awarded and this is the 37th year for the NAB's Program of Grants. "Broadcasting" is defined as including traditional technologies such as radio and TV as well as more recent technologies such as digital radio, DTV/HDTV, DBS, satellite, Internet/Web/streaming and wireless communications.
