Christie is member of a three-person special topics panel session titled: Disability: How do textile and apparel scholars address this issue in our classroom, in our research/creative work and in our outreach to the community and the textiles and apparel industry?

There were more than 692 international submissions juried for the 2007 annual meeting, "On the Edge" in Los Angeles, November 7-11, including 18 special topics proposals.
