

NTID students win RIT College Bowl competition

Four deaf students representing NTID at a recent College Bowl competition on the RIT campus took first place among 16 teams and the right to represent RIT at the regional competition, to be held at Cornell University February 20-21. Dubbed "The Varsity of the Mind" by organizers, the College Bowl is a question-and-answer game of quick recall played by teams of four students each, much like the television game show, "Jeopardy." The teammates were: Kevin Bernadt, a biology student from Scotia, New York; Katie Hoheusle, an imaging science student from Bethel, New York; William Huber, an information systems and mathematics student from Rye, New York; and Dan Milliken, a criminal justice student from Flourtown, Pennsylvania. Two, Bernadt and Hoheusle, represented NTID at the College Bowl competition held during the 1998 National Association of the Deaf convention.
