

CJ Jones featured in movie

The performance of Charles "CJ" Jones, a 1972 data processing graduate, in *The Ride*, a film directed by John Flanders, will be shown at a premiere Sunday, May 2, in Philadelphia. The film is the story of two men who appear to have little in common, but who forge a kind of determined communication that significantly influences each of their lives. Jones' character is silent and does not use any sign language. The film will be open captioned.

The premiere includes a full evening at The Prince Music Theater, Philadelphia's newest theater space, and will open at 5:30 pm with a dessert buffet followed by a screening of the film at 7 pm. After the film, a 30-minute sign-interpreted performance of the film's music will precede a question-and-answer session with the film's actors and songwriter.
