

## **NTID's College Bowl team formed**

Captained by a member of the 1996 team, NTID will defend its College Bowl championship for the third time against teams from Gallaudet University and California State University, Northridge.

Katie Hoheusle, third-year imaging science student from Bethel, New York, is this year's team captain. Her teammates are Kevin Bernadt, fourth-year biology student from Scotia, New York; Joe Kramlinger, third-year marketing student from Longwood, Florida; and Paul Thompson, third-year physics student from Santa Monica, California. Timmy Stewart, fourth-year applied statistics student from Ardmore, Oklahoma, will be the team's alternate player; Timmy also competed on the 1996 winning team.

The competition will be held at the National Association of the Deaf biennial conference this July in San Antonio, Texas. Dubbed "The Varsity of the Mind" by organizers, the College Bowl is a question-and-answer game of quick recall played by teams of four students each. At the NAD College Bowl, teams answer questions in eight categories, including arts and literature, geography, mathematics, science and nature, Deaf culture and history, politics and social studies, sports and leisure, and entertainment.
